COMBINED	Democrat	Undecided	Republican
> President	63	10	27
> U.S. Senate	55	17	28
> U.S. House	56	19	25

States: AZ, CO, FL, NV, VA

- June 12-21, 2012, Latino registered voters
- n=2000 combined +/- 2.1%; n=400 per state, +/- 4.9%

- 55% know an undocumented immigrant
- 30% know someone who has faced immigration proceedings

> U.S. House	66	18	16

- 68% know an undocumented immigrant
- 37% know someone who has faced immigration proceedings





<u>Colorado</u>

> President	70	8	22
> U.S. Senate			
> U.S. House	65	16	19

- 60% know an undocumented immigrant
- 35% know someone who has faced immigration proceedings





Florida

> President	53	10	37
> U.S. Senate	50	18	32
> U.S. House	48	21	31

- 45% know an undocumented immigrant
- 24% know someone who has faced immigration proceedings

> President	69	11	20
> U.S. Senate	53	17	30
> U.S. House	62	15	23

- 74% know an undocumented immigrant
- 41% know someone who has faced immigration proceedings





<u>Virginia</u>


VIRGINIA	Democrat	Undecided	Republican

- 33% know someone who has faced immigration proceedings








