

**WEEK 6:** Latino Decisions tracking poll of Latino registered voters was conducted from September 17 – 31, 2010 with Latino registered voters in 21 states that comprised 94 of the Latino electorate in 2008. Interviews were conducted by telephone in English and Spanish, at the discretion of the respondent. Data are weighted to known CPS estimates for state, language, and the weighted sample produced 355 surveys for a margin of error of +/- 5.2 percent.
