





Watershed Moment...


□ Latino net contribution to Obama a 5.4% margin;

□ National popular vote margin is Obama +2.3%;

- □ For the first time in US history, Latino vote can plausibly claim to be nationally decisive:
 - If Latinos had split their vote evenly, Obama loses PV;
 - □ In fact, if Romney breaks 35% of Latinos, Obama loses PV.



Latino Vote for President by State




Latino Vote U.S. Senate

- □ Senator-elect Martin Heinrich prevailed by 5.6% of the vote;
- Latinos comprise 39.7% of the turned out NM electorate;
- □ Latino contribution to Heinrich's total was a net 21.8%, much larger than his margin;
- Senator-elect Heinrich joins Sen. Bennett and Sen. Reid in directly owing his seat to Latino vote.










States: Obama Latino Outreach






States: Romney Latino Outreach




National: Deferred Action Policy Impact

Did deferred action policy make you feel more enthusiastic, less enthusiastic, or did not change feelings about Obama?




National: Romney Policy Position Impact


Did Romney's immigration policy positions make you feel more enthusiastic, less enthusiastic, or did not change feelings about Romney?





States: Romney Policy Position Impact






Immigration causes GOP to leave votes on the table...

If GOP took a role in passing comprehensive reform with a path to citizenship, would it make you more likely to vote Republican?


National: Know Undocumented Immigrants

do you happen to know someone who is an undocumented immigrant?








Fixing the Deficit...

A note about exit poll estimates...

- NEP estimates continue to raise questions:
 - What percent of non-white voters were college educated?
 - What percent of Latino interviews completed the poll in Spanish?
 - Why have national and state numbers been revised already? From 69% to 71% just last night...
- Several suspicious estimates of Democratic vote:
 - Ohio—NEP 56%, LD 82%
 - Nevada—NEP 69%, LD 80%
 - □ Virginia—NEP 53%, LD 66%
- Latino Decisions will validate our results and theirs against precinct-level retinated
