**Poll Methodology.** On behalf of NALEO Educational Fund, Latino Decisions interviewed 606 Latino registered voters nationwide from April 9-15, 2019 and carries of margin of error of 3.9%. Respondents were randomly selected from Latino Decisions partner web panels and confirmed to be registered to vote. All respondents self-reported their race or ethnicity and people who confirmed they were Hispanic or Latino continued the survey. The survey was self-administered via smart phone, tablet or computer and available in English or Spanish at the discretion of the respondent. Data were compared to the best known estimates of the U.S. Census Current Population Survey (CPS) for demographic profile of Latino registered voters and weights were applied to bring the data into direct balance with Census estimates for the Latino registered voter population.
