





What are the most important issues facing the Latino community that politicians should address?











How important is it for federal government to take measures to reduce carbon pollution that causes climate change?











View of Democratic Party Toward Latino Community




View of Republican Party Toward Latino Community




Immigration Salience

How important is the issue of immigration in your decision to vote, and who to vote for in this election?




Republican Party Standing

Which do you agree with most?




Ties to Undocumented Immigrants

Do you happen to know somebody who is an undocumented immigrant?




Language Media Consumption

When it comes to news and information about politics and elections, how often do you use or rely on Spanish language television or English language television




2016 Presidential Election

If the 2016 Presidential election were held today, would you vote for the Democratic candidate for President, or the Republican candidate for President?




Favorability National Political Figures




Executive Action Impact on Democrats
