# Methodology

On behalf of the Latino Victory Project, Latino Decisions surveyed 300 Latino registered voters between July 18<sup>th</sup> and July 19<sup>th</sup>. All surveys were conducted online, in English or Spanish according to the respondent's preference. The survey carries a margin of error of +/- 5.6 percentage points.
