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

- n=500, MoE 4.3%




• What do you think is the most important issue that President Obama, and the Congress should address over the next year?






With all the different issues the Congress and President must address, how important do you think it is that they should pass a bill on [immigration / health care] reform before the 2010 congressional election in November?


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
 Generally speaking, do you approve or disapprove of the job Barack Obama is doing as President?



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






 Generally speaking, do you think of yourself as a Republican, a Democrat, an independent, or something else?






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
 Thinking back over the past year since Obama became president, do you consider yourself more excited about the <u>Democratic Party</u> and what they are doing, or less excited about the Democrats?



Among Latino registered voters nationwide, March 2010




 Thinking back over the past year since Obama became president, do you consider yourself more excited about the <u>Republican Party</u> and what they are doing, or less excited about the Republicans?






• Thinking back over the last year since Obama became president and the Democrats have had control of the Congress, how enthusiastic are you about voting in the November 2010 elections?






 However, the more crucial point of comparison is Latino Dem excitement compared to White Republican excitement.... Which is unknown, but expected to be somewhat high







Latino Democratic Affinity May 2009 – Nov 2010

























Predicted Probability of Voter Turnout in 2010






Predicted Probability of Voter Turnout in 2010







 Anticipated Voter Turnout Among Latino Registered Voters by year for 2006, 2008, 2010









 Anticipated Voter Turnout Among Latino Registered Voters by year for 2006, 2008, 2010




Intended Vote for Congress
