Methodol ogy: 2, 045 regi stered voters were intervi ewed in the 61 congressional districts deemed most competitive by Cook CNN and Crystal Ball, and the over al poll has a margin of error of $H-2.1 \%$ A mimmof 400 regi stered voters were int ervi ewed from each raci al and et hnic group: Lati nos, African Americans, Asi an Americans or Pacific Islanders, Native Americans, and white non-Hi spani cs, which each carry a margin of error of $H-4.8 \%$ Due to sample size consider ations, Native Americans were drawn froma 50 -state national sample, while the ot her four groups were drawn only fromthe 61 competitive districts. The overal data are wei ghted to the nost recent census estimates for the regi ster ed voter popul ation for age, gender, education, and nativity, and then wei ghted proportionately to match the over all racial denographics of the conbi ned 61 di stricts which is $68 \%$ white, $15 \% \mathrm{bl}$ ack, $12 \%$ Lati no, $4 \%$ Asi an, $1 \%$ Native American. Respondents were randony sel ected for interviews through online panel s, and verified to be regi stered to vote, and to live in one of the 61 competitive house districts, in order to participate in the survey. The survey was in the field J uly $5-\mathrm{J}$ ul y 14, 2018.
