



How much of a problem is racism against immigrants and Latinos today?






White supremacists pose a threat to the U.S. today






Would you say the Republican Party is currently doing a good job reaching out to Latinos, that they don't care that much, or that they are being hostile towards Latinos

Mostly ignoring / doesn't care Being hostile to Latinos





2020 Presidential vote intention among Latinos (Sept 2019)









Latino vote in Texas 2014 to 2018





Latino vote in Texas 2014 to 2018




