# Survey Methodology

- 2
- N=1,004 Texas registered voters; Latino oversample n=504
- Field dates: February 21-26, 2020
- English or Spanish, according to respondent preference
- Blended sample, online and live telephone interviews (cell and landline)
- Margin of error for Texas statewide <u>+</u> 3.1 percentage points
- Margin of error for Latino oversample <u>+</u> 4.4 percentage points







#### **Texas Statewide**






















## **Personal Economic Situation**

(President Trump often states that unemployment is very low and the stock market is doing very well. Do you feel that you have personally benefited, or not, from Donald Trump's economic policies?)






### Medicare for All



(Generally speaking, how much of a problem do you think racism against Latinos and immigrants is today?)




