



#### 2020 ARIZONA VOTER POLL

## Survey Methodology

- N=1,036 Arizona registered voters; Latino oversample N=502
- > Field dates: March 6-11, 2020
- English or Spanish, according to respondent preference
- Blended mode: online and live phone interviews (cell and landline)
- Margin of error Arizona statewide + 3.0 percentage points
- Margin of error for Latino oversample + 4.4 percentage points







## **Trump Approval**








#### Arizona U.S. Senate Race




([Among Democrats] If the Democratic Primary candidates are Joe Biden and Bernie Sanders, who will you vote for?)






#### Presidential Vote – Generic Democrat


(Thinking ahead to the 2020 election for President of the United States, do you plan to vote for Donald Trump or the Democratic nominee?)

(If the presidential candidates are Trump and [Biden/Sanders] who will you vote for?)








## Will Democrats Vote for Any Democrat?




Are there any candidates that you would absolutely not vote for under any condition?







(Do you care more about a candidate's past statements and policies, or more about what a candidate supports today?)




#### Candidate Attributes – Arizona Statewide

(Are you more likely or less likely to support a candidate for President who is described as...)




#### Candidate Attributes – Arizona Latinos

(Are you more likely or less likely to support a candidate for President who is described as...)




#### Personal Economic Situation

#### Medicare for All


(Do you support/ oppose moving towards a Medicare for all health insurance system that guarantees health care for everyone?)






# Immigration Policies: Border Wall and DREAMers

Do you favor or oppose building a wall along the 2,000-mile border between the United States and Mexico?




Do you support or oppose creating a permanent pathway to citizenship for DREAMERS – young undocumented immigrants who were brought to the country as children, but were raised in this country?
