**About the poll:** Latino Decisions interviewed n=1,829 Latino adults nationwide from May 10 - 16, 2020. Respondents answers questions on their cell phone or landline with live callers, or via online self-responses through text or email invitations. The invitation and survey were both available in English or Spanish, and overall 41% of respondents answered in Spanish. Overall, the full sample contains a margin of error of +/- 2.3%. Some questions were just asked of registered voters (n=1,251) which contains margin of error of +/- 2.8%. State oversamples averaged approximately 240 respondents and have a margin of error of +/- 6.3%.
